

Directions:

- 1. Layethe into pieces of fleece out so that the wrong sides are together (both right sides are facing out) and the edges are even. Trim off the raw edge from both piece sides are together (both right sides are facing out) There should be no white border with writing, no curled of frayed ends on the fleece edge. both pieces. - 2. Take the 3 1/2" X 3 1/2" Cardboard and fay it on the corr of your blanker: "XThen cut obtarthen 3 11/2t'on 3nd/2" corner through both layers of fleacet of receding this on al four 1 corners. the bis set any will act as

a guide of where to stop cutting up for fringe) 3. Now you are ready to cut fringes. Cut the fringes 3 1/2 inches deep and read the stars of fleece.^{1/}Continue cutting the fringes for all four sides. layers of fleece. Continue cutting the fringes on all

4. Novethattene fringes are all cut in pairs, tie each pair into a double knot (close to the blanket) all the way arour
